INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

2 Phillips-head screws

1 Moonroof visor

2 Stainless steel retention clips

2 Self-locking nuts

2 Pieces of protective tape

TOOLS AND SUPPLIES REQUIRED

10 mm combination wrench

#2 Phillips screwdriver

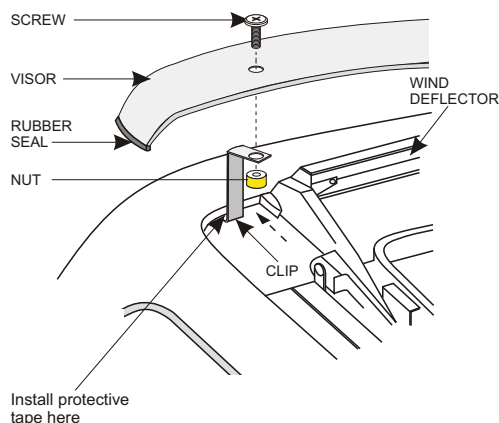
Masking tape

INSTALLATION

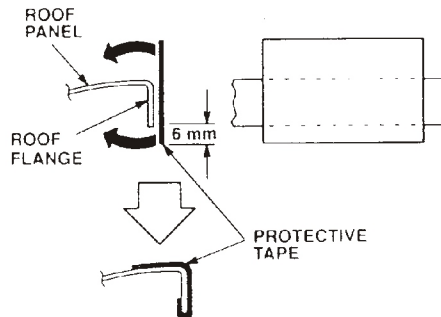
Before you begin:

Wash and wax the roof around the front and sides of the moonroof opening before installing the visor.

1. Open the moonroof.
2. Insert a phillips-head screw through each of the holes on the top of the visor, then loosely install the clips and self-locking nuts.



3. Set the moonroof visor on the car's roof, forward of the moonroof opening, and adjust its position so it is equally spaced on all sides.
4. Attach a short strip of masking tape to both sides of the car's roof above the point where the clips will attach to the moonroof opening. Remove the visor.
5. Remove the adhesive backing from one of the pieces of protective tape, then attach the tape to the lip and underside of the moonroof opening, in line with the masking tape. Repeat for the other side. Remove the masking tape.



6. Reposition the moonroof visor over the moonroof opening. Check once again for equal spacing. While holding the moonroof visor in place, reach under visor while applying downward pressure at screw locations and hook
7. Ensure the rubber seal around the perimeter is not twisted or rolled under the visor as screws are tightened.
8. Tighten the nuts and screws, alternating between sides, until clips just touch the deflector. Apply downward pressure at screw locations while tightening screws in order to maintain correct rubber seal position as stated above. Do not overtighten the screws.
9. Once installation is complete check to see that the moonroof does not contact the existing spring loaded wind deflector. If they are in contact, loosen screws slightly and slide the visor forward to clear the wind deflector. Once this is complete re-tighten screws.

CARE OF YOUR MOONROOF VISOR

NOTICE

Never use ammonia-based cleaners or solvents to clean your moonroof visor.

1. Clean with mild soap and water using a soft cloth or chamois.
2. To remove fine scratches and restore the original luster, use a high quality plastic care cleaner.
